04 Nights / 05 Days

Day 01 Arrive Perth

Arrive at Perth airport. Our local representative will be waiting at the airport to welcome you and transfer you to your hotel. Perth is in Western Australia situated on the beautiful Swan River. The city centre bustles with activity and offers a range of choices for shopping. There are many fun activities in the city centre, many of which is focused around the picturesque Swan River. You can enjoy one of the many river cruises which operate along the river, some offering dining and music as you spend a few hours cruising in and out of the city. For spectacular panoramic views of Perth and the river, visit Kings Park and Botanic garden and take advantage of the many lookouts and vantage points available to the public, or enjoy a relaxing picnic in one of the many recreation areas of the park. Spend a sunny day exploring the river by walking or cycling your way along the foreshore on one of the many cycle and walking tracks provided, or take part in water fun sports and scenic flights. The Swan River also provides an excellent scenic backdrop to enjoy while dining in Perth, and many restaurants have excellent river views where you can enjoy delicious meals while taking in the surrounding landscape. Take a half day city tour and visit the up market suburbs of Peppermint Grove, Dalkeith, Old Swan brewery, Royal Perth Yacht Club, Kings Park and Federation Walkway. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 02 Perth – Fremantle

After breakfast proceed for full day tour of Fremantle. See the docks, marinas and heritage sandstone buildings. Fremantle is Perth's port city, just a short drive or train ride south of the Perth City centre. Affectionately known by locals as Freo, Fremantle was originally Perth's access port for ships bringing supplies when Perth was just a colony. Fremantle was also the first port of call for fishing boats and vessels with their fresh catch of the day. If you love fresh seafood, then you will find an amazing choice in Fremantle so stop in at one of the local restaurants and enjoy a fresh cooked seafood meal. Fremantle's Fishing Boat Harbour has a number of restaurants with waterside views, specializing in local fresh fish and seafood dishes. A visit to Fremantle would not be complete without a stop at the local markets. At busy Fremantle Markets on South Terrace you will find an unusual range of items, from fresh fruit and produce, to jewellery and hand crafted local items. The E Shed Markets in Victoria Quay overlooks the Fremantle wharf and offers a range of interesting shops and is well worth a look. You can also grab a bite to eat in the E Shed Food court, or enjoy one of the many cafes. Evening return back to Perth. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 03 Perth –4WD Pinnacles, Koalas and sand boarding tour - Caversham and Nambung National Park

After breakfast Enjoy Perth's Swan Valley tour on own is only a short 20 minutes from the city, and is a great destination for a day trip from Perth. The Swan Valley Region is steeped in history and is one of Western Australia's oldest wine regions. The region is home to more that 40 vineyards, many of which are still run by the descendants of families who originally came from Europe and started the wineries many years ago. One of the unique characteristics of the Swan Valley for wine lovers, is that it is particularly renowned for high quality fortified wines, such as Muscats, Ports and a number of unique liqueur wines which are available direct from the cellar door and are not produced anywhere else. Fine wine and food certainly make great companions, and the Swan Valley has a number of local restaurants and cafes where you can

enjoy the local wine, beer and delicious food often made with fresh local produce. Relaxed alfresco dining is a popular feature of the Swan Valley particularly in summer, and many of the eateries and restaurants have bright yet shady undercover areas for a casual dining experience, somewhat reminiscent of a Mediterranean holiday. Then visit the Caversham Wildlife Park and Nambung National Park. Visit The Pinnacles desert which has limestone pillars. Ride the Desert Storm Adventure – take a 4WD sand dunes tour. Evening return back to Perth. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 04 Perth – Rottnest Island

After breakfast proceed for tour of Rottnest Island. Just off the West Coast Perth is the small island of Rottnest, measuring just 11 Kms. The island has a colourful history and since first settlement it was used for a number of different purposes, including a penal colony and prison, pastoral land and farming, a Governors residence and a military training area before becoming the recreational island it is today. The island is known by locals as "Rotto", and the island is easily accessible by ferry. The trip takes approximately 30 to 60 minutes depending on where you depart from, and Rottnest ferry services are available from Perth City, Fremantle and Hillarys. It is a popular holiday destination for locals and tourists, and because of its close proximity to Perth your stay there can be as long or short as you like. As an added bonus there are no cars allowed on the island, this means there are no traffic jams Popular island activities include cycling around the island and exploring at a leisurely pace as well as swimming or sunbaking on any of the often quiet and secluded beaches. With over 60 beaches to choose there is no shortage of choice. Rottnest is also one of the best locations around Perth for snorkeling and scuba diving, and the pristine waters are home to a myriad of interesting fish, sea life and coral. There are a number of reefs to explore as well as old shipwreck sites. For more activity, the island also offers other pursuits such as golf, mini golf, tennis and lawn bowls. The island offers something for everyone from cafes and take-away to a nice restaurant meal. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 05 Depart Perth

After breakfast check out and transfer to the airport for your departure flight.
