1	Jaipur	Afternoon	Arrive Jaipur and check in at hotel Lunch at hotel or at local restaurant. After lunch proceed for half day city sightseeing of Jaipur visiting/viewing The City Palace – residence of the former ruler and renowned for its stunning architecture also houses a museum, Hawa Mahal or the palace of winds once a viewing gallery used by the ladies of the palace to view the outside world, Jantar Mantar or Royal Observatory built in 1716 by Maharaja Jai Singh-II
		Evening	Visit to Birla temple , Return back to hotel Overnight at hotel
2	Jaipur	Morning	Breakfast at hotel After breakfast visit to Amer fort and enjoy Elephant ride at Amer fort - The Amer Fort was built in the 16th century by Sawai Raja Man Singh. It is made of red sandstone and white marble. Within the Amer Fort some areas that should not be missed are Jai Mandir, Sukh Niwas, Sheesh Mahal and Ganesh Pole . The Amber Fort and the Jaigarh Fort , Jaigarh - Jai means victory and garh means fort, so Jaigarh means the Fort of Victory, being basically one construction, is one the most spectacular forts in India, with almost all its original facilities intact. The fort was built in 1726 and the world's largest cannon on wheels can be seen here.
		Afternoon	Return Back to hotel for lunch (Optional) After lunch rest of the day at leisure relax at the hotel or shop as Jaipur offers a plethora of shopping opportunities some to include jewelry, silver, ethnic clothes etc.
		Evening	<u>Enjoy dinner at Choki Dani (Optional)</u> – Theme Village (Approx 25 kms from Jaipur) Overnight at hotel

6	Bikaner Jaisalmer	Morning Afternoon Evening	Breakfast at hotel. After breakfast proceed to Jaisalmer(approx 335 kms) Arrive Jaisalmer & check in at hotel. Visit Sam dunes (approx 40 kms - one way) to enjoy Camel Safari and view sunset. Return back to hotel. Overnight at hotel.
7	Jaisalmer	Morning Afternoon Evening	Breakfast at hotel. After breakfast proceed for half day city tour of Jaisalmer visiting/viewing the silent 12th century fort built by Prince Jaisal, Maharawal, Armoury, Museum , The Palace which stands at the highest point (100 meters) above the marketplace. Also visit the Jain Temples (12th -15th century) which lie within the fort complex. Visit Salim Singh ki Haveli, Patwon ki Haveli, Nathmal ki Haveli the last of the great havelis. Also visit Gadi-sar an artificial lake that was an important source of water in the past. After lunch rest of the day at leisure OR Enjoy dune safari by 4 x 4 wheel vehicle or by Quad bikes with lavish dinner (Optional) Return back to hotel Overnight at hotel
8	Jaisalmer Jodhpur	Morning Afternoon Evening	Breakfast at hotel. After breakfast proceed to Jodhpur (Approx 270 kms) Arrive Jodhpur & check in at hotel. After lunch relax at hotel Visit Umaidbhawan Palace This monumental piece of architecture stands on a sprawling 26 acre estate on Chhattar hill, on the eastern fringe of town. Built between 1929 and 1943 by Maharaja Umaid Singh the primary idea behind the project was to employ and provide relief to 3,000 workers during a long famine. No cement was used in its construction, and the interlocking blocks of sandstone simply take your breath away, especially while standing under the imposing 56 meter (183 feet) high central dome. Return back to hotel. Overnight at Hotel.

9	Jodhpur	Morning Afternoon	<p>Breakfast at hotel.</p> <p>After breakfast proceed to sightseeing of Mehrangarh Fort which is said to be 5 km long and one of the largest forts in India. There are some beautiful palaces located within the fort like Moti Mahal (The Pearl Palace), Phool Mahal (The Palace Of Flowers), Sheesh Mahal (The Hall Of Mirrors), Sileh Khana and the Daulat Khana. Jaswant Thada built in honor of Maharaja Jaswant Singh in the 19th century, this royal cenotaph is built in white marble which, visit the Clock Tower,</p> <p>Return back to hotel for lunch</p> <p>After lunch proceed to Mandore (Approx 10 kms) visiting Hall of Heroes The stunning feature of this hall is that the sculptures are carved with one single rock. Mandore Garden Mandore was the former capital of Maharajas of Marwar and is located about 5 miles north of Jodhpur but was later abandoned for the security of Mehrangarh fort. Here you will find the dewals or cenotaphs of Jodhpur's former rulers. Today its extensive gardens with high rock terrace make it a popular local attraction.</p> <p>Return back to hotel .</p> <p>Overnight at Hotel.</p>
10	Jodhpur Udaipur	Morning L. Afternoon	<p>Breakfast at hotel</p> <p>After breakfast drive to Udaipur via Ranakpur (Approx 280 kms, 7 hours). Ranakpur temple - the cluster of temples, made of intricately sculpted white marble built in 1460, the main temple is supported on 1, 444 pillars.</p> <p>Arrive Udaipur and check in at hotel.</p> <p>Rest of the day at leisure. Enjoy amenities at the hotel</p> <p>Overnight at hotel</p>

11	Udaipur	Morning	<p>Breakfast at hotel</p> <p>After breakfast proceed for half day city tour of Udaipur visiting/viewing City Palace built in 1725 the museum at the city palace contains incomparable historic and artistic heritage which dates back 14 centuries, Jagdish Temple dedicated to Lord Vishnu the temple was built in 1651 by Maharana Jagat Singh 1, Pratap Memorial atop the Moti Magri or pearl hill, overlooking the Fateh Sagar Lake is the memorial of Rajput hero Maharana Pratap with bronze statue of the Maharana. Rana Pratap sits atop his celebrated horse Chetak. Rana. Pratap is the fierce symbol of nationalism for this region. Drive around Fateh Sagar Lake excavated in the late 17th century by Maharaja Jai Singh and later visit Bhartiya Lok Kala Museum in Udaipur showcases the folk art of India. It is one of the most visited museums of Udaipur as it exhibits the folk art of Rajasthan which is envied world over.</p>
		Evening	<p>Enjoy boat ride on Lake Pichola. Visit Saheliyon Ki Bari Gardens Saheliyon ki Bari (meaning Garden of the Maidens of Honor) is located in the northern part of Udaipur city. Built in the middle of 18th century by Maharana Sangram Singh, Saheliyon ki Bari is an ornamental garden below the embankment of Fateh Sagar Lake. This historic garden was constructed for the 48 women attendants who accompanied a princess as a part of dowry to Udaipur. Interestingly, these fountains are fed by the waters of Fateh Sagar Lake gushing through purpose-built ducts. Since the fountains purely run by water pressure and do not use modern pumps, in times of water shortage the fountains may not work. To add to the ambience of the garden, each water channel was designed to create a distinct sound so that the mingling of these sounds would create music.</p> <p>Overnight at hotel</p>
